Egyptian civilization's intriguing cosmology is revealed as you visit the valley of the king's, Habu Temple and Hatshepsut temple on the Nile's West bank. On the East bank visit Karnak arguably the greatest temple complex of them all. Then visit Luxor temple. Next a visit to Dendara and Abydos temples, depart from Luxor for the final leg of your journey in Sharm El Sheikh where we will visit the Moses Mountain and Saint Catherine's Monastery.

Daily Itinerary

Day 1: Sunday, February 17th, 2019

Arrival Cairo - Welcome to Egypt

Welcome to Egypt! You'll be met and assisted by a Tour representative at the Cairo airport and then escorted to the Mena House Hotel.

Day 2: Monday, February 18th, 2019

Memphis / Step Pyramid at Sakkara / Abusir

After breakfast we will visit **Memphis** and **Sakkara** the Pyramid of Djoser, or step pyramid is an archeological remain in the Saqqara necropolis, northwest of the city of Memphis. It was built 27th century BC during the Third dynasty for the burial of Pharaoh Djoser by his vizier, Imhotep, then tour a date palm farm and visit a training center for carpet marking, After lunch we will visit **Abusir Pyramids** for about two hours or more. Then back to the hotel.

Day 3: Tuesday, February 19th, 2019

The pyramids and Sphinx

In the early morning there will be an optional opportunity to have **private time inside to the Great Pyramid King's Chamber and Queen's Chamber.**

After breakfast we will visit the last remaining Wonder of the Ancient World the **Great Pyramids** and the **Sphinx**. After Lunch back to the hotel.

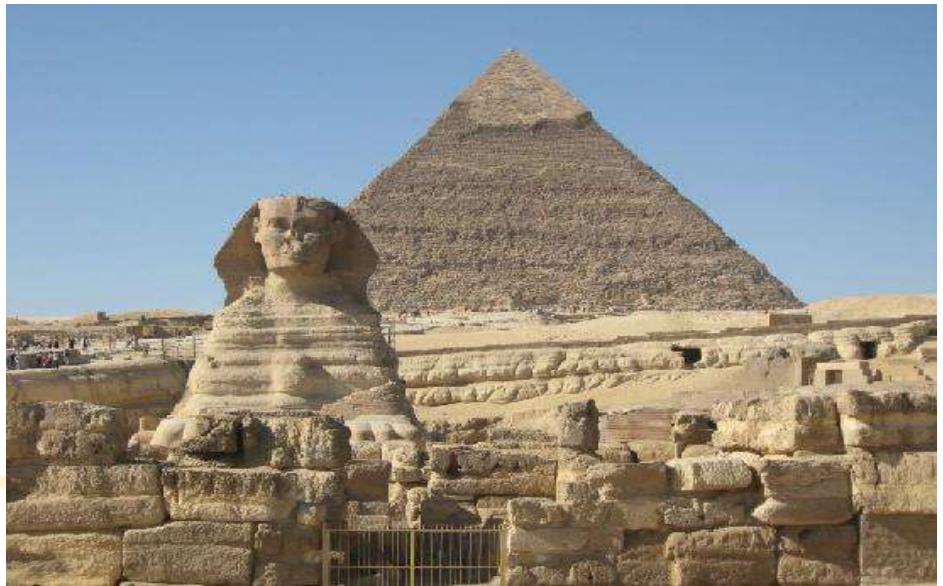
Day 4: Wednesday, February 20th, 2019

Egyptian Museum and Alabaster Mosque

After Breakfast we will go to the **Cairo Egyptian Museum**. This museum contains many important pieces of ancient Egyptian history and houses the world's largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities. This includes many treasures from the tomb of King Tutankhamen. Then we will go to visit the great Alabaster Mosque. Situated on the summit of a centuries-old citadel, this is a fine example of an Ottoman-era mosque. Then Evening Depart to Aswan by flight and Overnight.

Day 5: Thursday, February 21st, 2019

Aswan Dam and Isis Temple

After breakfast we will visit **Philae Temple**. It was dedicated to the goddess Isis, the wife of Osiris and mother of Horus. These three characters are very important in ancient Egyptian life, culture and art. Then a visit to The **High Dam**. In the afternoon we will take a ride aboard a felucca, sailing around Kitchener's Island, after that depart by a motorboat to sail on the Nile to the **Botanical Gardens** and The **Nubian Village** that is located on West Bank of the River Nile in Aswan and just opposite to Soheil Island and near the Aswan Dam passing by the First Cataract of Aswan, this fantastic tour to the Nubian Village with **camel ride** on the desert lets you meet and impact with a Nubian family and to learn about their simple life style, culture and traditions, back to the hotel.

Day 6: Friday, February 22nd, 2019

Abu Simbel Temple and Nubian Museum

After breakfast we will depart by bus for **Abu Simbel**. The two temples in the Abu Simbel complex were carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II, in the 13th century BCE, as a lasting monument to himself and his queen, Nefertari. After that we head back to Aswan, then the Tour staff will transfer you from the Aswan Movenpick hotel to the **5 Star Luxury Nile cruise ship**. Lunch on board, Afternoon we will visit the **Nubian Museum**, dedicated to Nubian history, culture and art. After the museum we will have the opportunity to enjoy high tea at a Nubian café, and watch the sunset. Then back to the Cruise.

Day 7: Saturday, February 23rd, 2019

Kom-Ombo and Horus Temples

The ship will set sail. After breakfast we will journey first to **KomOmbo Temple**. The northern half was dedicated to the god Horus, and the Southern half to the crocodile god, Sobek. After the tour, we will return to the cruise ship and continue sailing to Edfu. After Lunch enjoy a visit to the **Temple Of Horus** in Edfu. It is one of the best preserved temples in Egypt and was dedicated the Falcon-headed god, Horus. After the tour, we will return to the ship and continue on to Luxor, passing through the Esna Lock.

Day 8: Sunday, February 24th, 2019

Dendara and Abydos Temples

After breakfast we will travel by bus to **Dendara Temple**. It is one of the best-preserved temple complexes in Egypt and contains the Temple of Hathor. Afterwards, we will visit the temple at **Abydos**, dedicated to Pharaoh Seti I. Abydos one of the oldest cities of ancient Egypt, dating to pre-dynastic times, and was the site of many ancient temples.

Then we will return to the Hotel

Day 9: Monday, February 25th, 2019

Valley of the Kings & Hatshepsut Temple

After breakfast (by 7:30 AM) we will transfer off the Cruise Ship, and journey to the **Valley of the Kings**, also called the Valley of the Gates of the Kings. For a period of nearly 500 years, from the 16th to 11th century BC, tombs were constructed there for the Pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom. The valley stands on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis. After that we will go to the Ibis Alabaster shop for an opportunity to shop for souvenirs and gifts. Afterwards we will visit the nearby **Temple of Queen-Hatshepsut**. This mortuary temple is dedicated to the sun god Amon-Ra and is located next to the mortuary temple of Mentuhotep II. Afterwards we will visit **Habu Temple**. After lunch we will return to Luxor and check into the Maritim Jolie Ville Luxor Hotel. Evening time a visit to Adel's Oil Shop.

Day 10: Tuesday, February 26th, 2019

Karnak and Luxor Temples

After breakfast we will visit **Karnak Temple**. The temple complex has four parts. The most commonly visited one is the Precinct of Amun-Ra. In addition to this precinct we will visit the three other parts: the Precinct of Mut, the Precinct of Montu, and the ruins of the Temple of Amenhotep IV (more commonly known as Ankhentenaten.). Then proceed to visit Adel's Oil Shop (For the people who want to do a session). Free time to enjoy the resort. In the evening (around 6:00 PM) we will visit the **Luxor Temple**.

This is a large ancient temple complex, located on the east bank of the Nile River, and was founded in 1400 BCE. After touring the temple we will return to the hotel.

Overnight: Luxor / Maritim Jolie Ville Hotel

Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner



Day 11: Wednesday, February 27th, 2019

Fly to Sharm El Sheikh

After breakfast. Our tour staff will transport you by bus to the Luxor airport, to fly to Sharm El Sheikh through Cairo airport. Upon arrival in Sharm, we will go to the resort then free at leisure.

At 11:00 pm we will drive to St. Catherine, takes about two and half hours driving. Start climbing the Moses Mountain begins at 2:00 am to see sunrise from atop Moses' Mountain and coming down at 7:00 am next day (Day 12). Descent after dawn to visit St. Catherine Monastery which is considered one of the most famous monasteries in the world and it was dedicated to one of Alexander's rulers, Saint Catherine who was tortured to death for the sake of her new faith. You can Travel through by day to Mount Sinai to climb the mountain at day to see sunset from atop Moses' Mountain. Then back to your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh.

Overnight: Sharm / Sultan Garden Beach Resort.

Meals: All Inclusive Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner



Day 12: Thursday, February 28th, 2019

Moses Mountain and St. Catherine Monastery

Breakfast after coming down from the mountain and after touring the St. Catherine Monastery we will drive back to the hotel.

Free at leisure enjoy the beach rest of day.

Day 13: Friday, March 1st, 2019

Desert Safari tour

Breakfast at the resort then we will drive off into the desert, away from the resort in Sharm el-Sheikh and into the more authentic landscape of Egypt. The desert tour will take you into a canyon, fill your belly with Bedouin food, and enjoy a fast-paced quad bike tour through the sand dunes. Visit a Bedouin village, where you can learn more about the lives of the desert inhabitants and enjoy a traditional Lunch and we can enjoy a camel ride, admire the impressive fire show, and marvel at the beautiful starry sky through a telescope.

Full day Sea Trip

After Breakfast we will go to the jetty sailing for two hours by private boat (only for us) towards the north east of Sharm El Sheikh along the Gulf of Aqaba, which is more than 1800 meter deep, until reaching the beautiful place called Blue Laguna. It is a perfect site to dive, snorkel or just swim. The Laguna is not deep but there are a lot of coral reefs and fishes there. Then continue to sail towards Tiran Island where you can make a great snorkeling or swim. Have lunch on the boat. Then sail back to the jetty of Sharm El Sheikh and overnight the hotel.

After breakfast. Tour staff will transfer you to the Cairo Airport and assist you for the final departure from Egypt with memories to last a **lifetime!** 😊

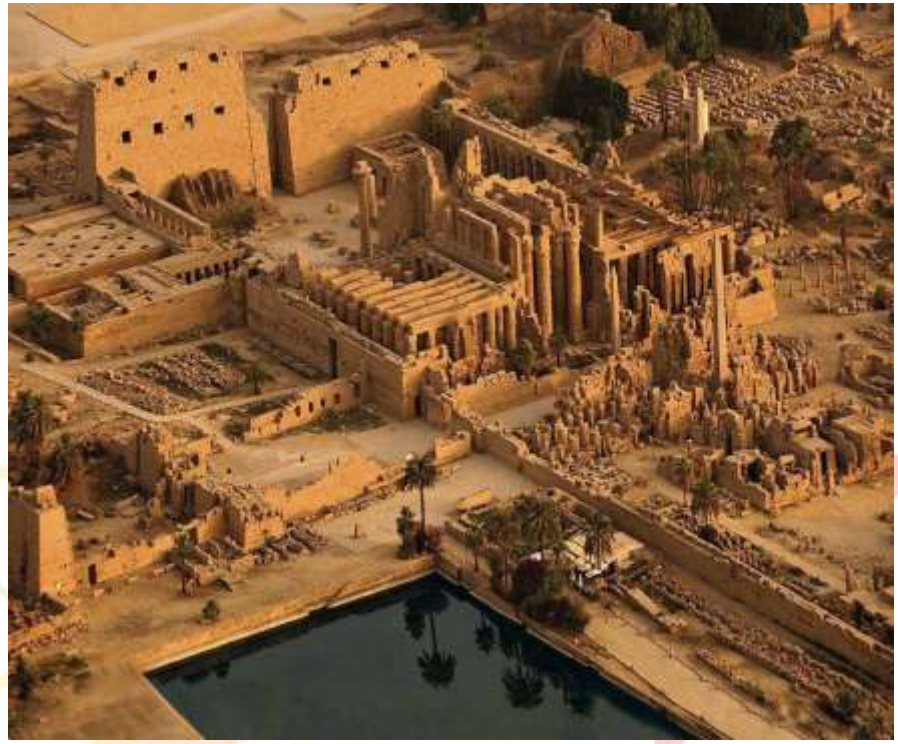
